



Everyone Belongs School Kindness Grant Nomination Process

1. The Choose Kindness Foundation will identify and invite persons with knowledge about and direct contact with schools to be Everyone Belongs Kindness grant nominators.
2. Nominators should take into account the following eligibility considerations regarding schools to nominate for the Everyone Belongs Kindness grant program.
School eligibility considerations include:
 - High percent of free/reduced lunch eligibility
 - High proportion of minority student
 - Strong interest in teaching/strengthening kindness in their school
 - Commitment to inclusiveness and equity
 - Proactive and Equitable discipline
 - Focus on Achieving positive academic outcomes
3. Nominators will reach out to potential schools and determine their interest in applying for the grant. Nominators may provide schools with the one-page description of the grant program. If a school's interest is established, nominators will email the completed nomination form including school details to jane@choosekindnessfoundation.info.
4. The Foundation will contact the nominated school and confirm their interest in applying for the grant program and describe the project and the requirements of the grant. The foundation will ask the nominated school to complete and return an Everybody Belongs School Kindness registration form.
5. Once the registration has been completed and reviewed, the Foundation will send the grant application packet and details about the application process to the nominated school.
